ORDER IMPLEMENTING STATEWIDE JUDICIAL EMERGENCY

On March 14, 2020, the Honorable Harold D. Melton, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia ordered and declared an amended Statewide Judicial Emergency in the State of Georgia due to the continued transmission of Coronavirus/COVID-19 throughout the State and the potential infection of those who work in or are required to appear in Georgia courts.

The undersigned, the Honorable Lawrence E. O'Neal, Chief Judge of the Georgia Tax Tribunal, hereby ADOPTS AND IMPLEMENTS the above-mentioned order as it relates to all proceedings before the Georgia Tax Tribunal.

Specifically, during the period of this Order, the undersigned hereby suspends, tolls, extends, and otherwise grants relief from any deadlines or other time schedules or filing requirements imposed by otherwise applicable statutes, rules, regulations, or court orders.

This Order shall terminate on April 13, 2020, at 11:59 p.m., unless otherwise extended.
